Dear Jessica,

Per my phone message, please note: A year ago, per your recommendation, we made a 310 application to your office. This application got transferred to Billings and from there was further directed to the Army Corps of Engineers, which gave us permission to proceed now under permit NOW-2017-01818-MTH, which to our understanding superseded the 310 protocol.

While the original application involved only 2 points of concern, severe flooding in April of this year, which made at one-point Hercules Road almost impassable, required emergency measures, at which point we contacted the Corp and where given the advice that we could proceed with emergency corrective action and should amend our application accordingly, which we did.

At this point the project is on hold until we hear further from the Army Corps of Engineers.

Be assured, that as responsible landowners and stewards of the Glastonbury Landowners Association, that we do not take this lightly, we will go the extra mile and we will seek resolution under Park Conservations District's Motto: "Local Common-Sense Conservation".
