Glastonbury Culvert Cleaning and Repair

Culvert cleaning and repair is done infrequently. It is not a budgeted item, and thus, it should come out of North and South Glastonbury road funds. According to the GLA Treasurer Regina Wunsch, North Glastonbury has \$52,943.34, and South Glastonbury has \$37,478.89, in their respective road funds.

I suggest that we, the Road Committee, budget \$10,000.00 for North Glastonbury culvert cleaning and repair. South Glastonbury should budget \$15,000.00 for culvert cleaning, repair and installation. It has been twenty to thirty years since our culverts have been maintained in any way whatsoever.

New culverts are needed at:

- The intersection of Hercules and Dry Creek
- The intersection of Polaris and Hercules

Equipment needed:

- Mini-excavator
- A water truck with a high pressure hose
- A skid steer with a post pounding attachment

The Skid Steer will be needed to pound posts to mark all culverts in the community. It could also be used with a bucket to haul away dirt and rocks dug out of the plugged culverts.

Preliminary Work Needed: All culverts, or as many as we can find, will need to be marked and mapped. We can use wooden stakes with yellow ribbons for marking. We can use Leo Keeler's aerial photo maps to place the culverts on the maps. Leo's maps are available here:
