17	THE COURT has reviewed Petitioner(s) Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and

19	Motion to Show Cause Why a Preliminary Injunction Should Not Issue and Declaratory Judgment			
20	Hearing Motion. The Petitioner, Kathleen Rakela, has alleged violations of the Association's rule			
21	making requirements that would directly impact her rights regarding the December 2, 2017			
22	election. Petitioner Rakela further alleges that an unpaid assessment for her property in North

26	in granting the relief set forth below would cause immediate and irreparable injury to Petitioner

there is insufficient time for service and an opportunity for Respondents to respond prior to the December 2, 2017 election, and the need to preserve potentially crucial evidence, the Temporary Restraining Order is entered pursuant to §27-17-315, M.C.A. to enjoin the Respondents pending a hearing and further Order of the Court.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- The GLA annual election now scheduled for December 2, 2017 is hereby postponed until this matter is resolved by further Order of the Court. The existing Directors' terms shall be extended pending a later election date.
- 2. The election ballots already cast for Petitioner Rakela and Marshall Haley shall be preserved until further Order of the Court.
- 3. The recordings of GLA Board meetings and Election Committee meetings from August, 2017 through the present shall be preserved until further Order of the Court.
- 4. A hearing on whether the Court should issue a preliminary injunction shall be held on Tuesday, January 2, 2018 at 1:30 p.m. The hearing shall be strictly limited to two hours, with each side having one hour in which to present testimony and evidence.
- 5. The Petitioner shall be responsible for serving this Order upon the Respondents no later than five (5) days prior to the hearing.
