Dear Board,

Enclosed is a petition with signatures from landowners who are members of the Glastonbury Landowners Association. The reason for the petition is to halt the election of Board of Directors scheduled for December 2, 2017 and to initiate a new and legal election process. The petitioners believe the Board of Directors and the Election Committee violated the Covenants and By-laws as required in Article XI para. C by not providing reasonable written notice in accordance with Article V, paragraph D of new Rules and Regulations when changing the requirements for voting and paying assessments and other monies owed at the time of the election pursuant to long standing practice of the Glastonbury Landowners Association (GLA). The petitioners also allege a conflict of Interest by candidates for re-election who are GLA board members voting on issues of non-board member candidates.

The last minute change regarding paying dues on the day of the election without proper notice and input from members will deprive some landowners of their legal right to vote. This petition is therefore being filed with Ms. Rakela's petition to the Montana Sixth Judicial District Court of Park County in support of a motion for a temporary restraining order.

Petition to Suspend Glastonbury Landowners Annual Meeting of December 2, 2017

The Board of Directors and the Election committee violated the Covenants and By-laws as required in Article XI para. C. by not providing a reasonable written notice in accordance with Article V, paragraph D. of new Rules and Regulations, changing the requirements for voting and paying assessments and other monies owed at the time of the election pursuant to long standing practice of the Glastonbury Landowners Association (GLA). Conflict of Interest from candidates for -re-election who are GLA board members voting on issues of non-board member candidates.

Be it resolved by the signatures of members of GLA that the changes directly affected all members by not allowing each member an opportunity to respond to the changes. Violations to the election process including but not limited to the definition of a "member in good standing" disenfranchised members from voting and being named on the ballot for election. Any proposed changes of the Board need to have a 30 day notice for response.

This petition is to initiate from the beginning the election process with a Nominating Committee that will take nominations from members in good standing and following through with all the requirements stated in the Covenants and By-laws.

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
